Who we are



About the role

The post holder will support the Digital Senior Producer in the Learning team to deliver festivals, workshops and drop-in events, with a focus on creative technologies and digital skills.

Working closely with artists, designers, educators, and colleagues across departments, the post holder will help develop inclusive, high-quality learning events, manage logistics and budgets, and support evaluation and audience engagement. This role requires a passion for art and design using digital technologies to inspire creativity and learning across diverse audiences.

- **Event delivery:** Prepare and support the delivery of digital programmes events, including co-delivering and facilitating when required. Coordinate event logistics by liaising with exhibitors to confirm required materials and equipment, and support the physical setup of event spaces.
 - **Work collaboratively** with a variety of creative practitioners, including designers, artists, educators, and colleagues across V&A departments
 - **Programme Development:** Support the Senior Producer in researching, planning and developing programme content designed to unlock the V&A's collections in new ways using creative technologies.
 - **Budget Management:** Oversee the programme budget and work with Senior Producer to ensure activities delivered on budget and generate income according to targets. Budget overview on relevant areas, with management by the Senior Producer.
 - **Diversity and Inclusion:** Promote equality and diversity in all aspects of working and grow new audiences.
 - **Impact:** Ensure effective implementation of V&A Learning's Impact Framework and programme evaluation. Monitor performance against targets and take timely action when necessary to ensure that they are met.
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What we're looking for

- Growth mindset: adaptive thinker with strong administrative skills and attention to detail, taking pride in their work.
- Demonstrable experience in delivering and developing at least one of the following types of learning events: design, play, performance, digital and/or STEAM.
- Experience working with museums or art organisations, and knowledge of design history and/or current practice.
- Effective budget management skills: ability to plan, manage and deliver events cost-effectively.
- Experience in managing freelance and contractor relationships.
- The ability to use MS Office and other relevant IT systems as appropriate for the role.
- Desirable: Familiar with digital design tools used in our making workshops, such as 3D modelling software, digital illustration or physical computing.
- Takes responsibility for delivering on actions, achieving high-standards and learning from mistakes.
- Open to change, new ideas and suggestions; looks for opportunities for improvement and self-development.
- Works with others outside their own department in a collaborative, understanding, and, engaging way.
